c) ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is:

- 1st closing date of entries (30/06/21) : maximum 220 € (Entry fee 170 € + 50 € paddock fee – all included)
- 2nd closing date of entries (08/07/21): maximum 275 € (Entry fee 225 € + 50 € paddock fee – all included)
- After 2nd closing date of entries (13/07/21): maximum 440 € (Entry fee 390 € + 50 € paddock fee – all included)

As the entry form from the Driver and the confirmation of the acceptance from the organiser is considered as a contract, the Driver, not coming to the Competition, has to apologise giving the reason as soon as possible.

The entry fee will be paid before (30/06/2021), closing date for entries:

- (20/06/2021), 1st closing date of entries
- (08/07/2021), 2nd closing date of entries

The podium ceremony on the circuit will be held immediately after the races. The winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes must be present wearing their race overalls. Failure to attend this ceremony will be penalized by the loss of any monetary award / benefit associated with the corresponding position at the end of the race.

The prize-giving will take place at 18.30 at the podium truck *

The Prizes will be awarded in euros. Price Amount, net of taxes, distributed

Cash Prizes will only be distributed if more than 1000 spectators are allowed to enter the Competition site. If less than 1001 spectators, no cash prizes will be distributed *. (Article 15.2.2. SR FIA)
