



## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR COMPETITIONS OF THE 2018 FIA EUROPEAN AUTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

### **Autocross of Mūsa** Round 2 of the 2018 FIA European Autocross Championship **Bauska (LVA), 01-03/06/2018**

This document contains the particularities of the Competition and is based on the currently valid Appendices to the International Sporting Code («the Code») and on the newest version of the Standard Regulations for Competitions of the FIA European Autocross Championship. For all articles not specified in this document, the Standard Regulations for Competitions of the FIA European Autocross Championship are valid. The Standard Regulations are distributed to each competitor in the FIA European Championship by his ASN. They are also posted on the Official Notice Board of each event. The numbering of the chapters is in accordance with the Standard Regulations.

### III. GENERAL CONDITIONS

#### 2. GENERAL

2.1 This Competition will count for:

- The 2018 FIA European Autocross Championship
- The 2018 FIA Autocross Nations Cup

#### 3. DESCRIPTION OF THE CIRCUIT

Location:	Road A7 Rīga – Vilnius 71 km (GPS coordinates: 56.381847, 24.259438 )

#### 5. ENTRY FORMS – ENTRIES

5.1 Anybody wishing to take part in the Competition must send the attached entry form duly completed to the Secretariat at: **rautoklubs@gmail.com**, fax: +371 67551465 **before 24/05/2018** (2<sup>nd</sup> Closing date).

5.2 The maximum number of starters will be 100

The maximum number of entries for a support race will be 20

#### 6. ENTRY FEES

6.1 The entry fee is:

- a) 1st closing date of entries: 220 € (Entry fee 170 € + 50 € paddock fee – all included)
- b) 2nd closing date of entries: 275 € (Entry fee 225 € + 50 € paddock fee – all included)
- c) After 2nd closing date of entries: 440 € (Entry fee 390 € + 50 € paddock fee – all included)

As the entry form from the Driver and the confirmation of the acceptance from the organiser is considered as a contract, the Driver, not coming to the Competition, has to apologise giving the reason as soon as possible.

**The entry fee will be paid before (24.05.2018), closing date for entries:**

- a) (18/04/2018), 1st closing date of entries
- b) (24/05/2018), 2nd closing date of entries

6.3 Entry fees may be refunded only:

- a) to candidates who are not accepted,
- b) in the case of the Competition not taking place,
- c) if the Competitor withdraws his entry no later than the Monday in week before the Competition. If the withdrawal is announced to the organiser between that Monday and the opening of the administrative checking, 50% only of the entry fee will be refunded.

#### 7. INSURANCE

7.1 The organizer will provide for an insurance policy by **AAS BALTA** , which covers the competitor's liability for civil responsibility toward third parties.

7.2 Liability insurance Sums insured is EUR 500.000 total coverage.

#### **V. RUNNING OF THE COMPETITION**

##### **12. PRACTICE AND DRIVERS' BRIEFING**

**12.1** A warm-up and two qualifying practice sessions, one organised in order of the numbers and the second in reverse order, are obligatory in each division.

There must be no more than 1 car at each 120m of the track in each qualifying practice session, which will be run over 4 laps minimum, starting from the car crosses the finish line, and all lap are counting.

The best lap time from all the qualifying practice sessions determines the starting positions for the first Heat. In the event of a tie, the next best lap time of the Drivers who have tied determines the starting positions.

Each Driver must complete at least one lap in practice. Should this not be the case, the Driver may be allowed to start in the first qualifying Heat, at the discretion of the stewards. Cars from different divisions will run separately.

**12.2** Briefing notes in English and optionally in the host language of the Competition will be given in writing to all Drivers at the administrative checking.

**12.3** A Drivers' briefing will be organised before the second qualifying practice session.

##### **14. QUALIFYING**

There will be 5 laps in the qualifying Heats.

##### **15. SEMI-FINALS AND FINALS**

There will be 6 laps in the Semi-Finals and 7 laps Finals.

#### **VI. PARC FERME – RESULTS – PROTESTS**

##### **20. PROTESTS – APPEALS**

**20.1** All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code.

All protests must be made in writing and handed to the clerk of the course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of € 500. If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit of €3000

**20.2** The amount of the appeal is €3,000. The International Court of Appeal will hear, in the context of a Competition of the FIA European Autocross Championship, appeals against decisions of the stewards of a Competition brought by organisers, Competitors, Drivers or other licence holders that are addressees of such decisions or that are individually affected by such decisions. In this case, the ASNs cannot refuse to give their assistance and agreement (Article 14.1.1 of the Disciplinary and Judicial Rules of the FIA).

#### **VII. PRIZES AND CUPS**

##### **21. PRIZES**

The podium ceremony on the circuit will be held immediately after the (finals) races.

The official prize-giving will take place at Stage or meeting tent close to main entrance to circuit at 19:00.

The winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes must be present wearing their race overalls. Failure to attend this ceremony will be penalized by the loss of any monetary award / benefit associated with the corresponding position at the end of the race.

The prizes will be awarded in Euros. Prize fund net of taxes distributed:

## VIII. OTHER INFORMATION

### 22. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each Driver is responsible for ensuring that a single piece extinguisher of **minimum 5 kg** is available within his own team area inside the paddock.

### 23. PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT

Each driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.

### 24. JUDICIAL CAMERAS

Throughout the Competition, all Competitors must have installed in their car a judicial camera. It is the responsibility of each Competitor to ensure that the camera is positioned in such a way that the track behind the car clearly visible, that the camera batteries are sufficiently charged and that the SD recording card is in place and has sufficient capacity to record all of the races. The penalty (up to disqualification from the Competition) for non-compliance will be at the discretion of the stewards. The weight of the camera system is included in the minimum weight of the car. The onus is on the Competitor to ensure the judicial camera is switched on and recording for all practice sessions, qualifying Heats, Semi-Finals and Finals. The camera must work as soon as the car enters the pre-grid area and must not be switched off until it returns to the paddock. Championship officials must be able to access the footage at all times during the Competition following a protest or otherwise. The images must be viewed using the equipment (computer) of the Competitor, who must ensure this equipment is working.

### 25. DRIVERS' LIAISON OFFICER

The Drivers' Liaison Officer will be recognisable by waistcoat with inscription "DRIVERS LIAISON OFFICER". He may be reached at:

- Presence at scrutineering
- Presence at the Secretariat of the Event
- Presence at the Stewards' meetings
- Presence in the paddock
- Presence in the starting area
- Presence near the Parc Fermé after the Finals
